Vincent E. Mikolay was elected as a Vice President on the Board of Trustees of Beta Theta Pi Fraternity in August 2010. He is serving a three-year term on the ten-member board, which guides the activities of more than 7,000 undergraduate members on 122 campuses in the U.S. and Canada, as well as some 123,000 alumni members of the 171-year-old Fraternity.

Mikolay, a 2000 graduate of Bethany College with a B.A. in communications, began his Beta career as a pledge of the Psi Chapter of Beta Theta Pi in 1997. Since then, Mikolay has been actively involved with the Fraternity holding numerous chapter officer positions including chapter president. He also served for four years on the Administrative Office staff in roles including Director of Leadership Development and the *Men of Principle* initiative. He also volunteered with local chapters in Southern California in many capacities including Chapter Counselor and District Chief, and he recently helped recolonize and support the chartering of the Gamma Tau Chapter of Beta Theta Pi at the University of Southern California. Mikolay's brother and late father are both honorary members of the Fraternity with General Fraternity roll numbers.

Mikolay holds a M.Ed. from Xavier University and an MBA in strategy and entrepreneurial studies from the University of Southern California. He has worked in several capacities for the Walt Disney Co., as well as launching several small businesses.
