Michael R. Okenquist was elected as a Vice President on the Board of Trustees of Beta Theta Pi Fraternity in August 2009. He is serving a three-year term on the ten-member board, which guides the activities of more than 7,000 undergraduate members on 122 campuses in the U.S. and Canada, as well as some 123,000 alumni members of the 171-year-old Fraternity.

Okenquist is Vice President of Marketing for The PNC Financial Services Company in Philadelphia, Penn. He has more than 10 years of experience in the financial services industry, serving in marketing roles with Delaware Investments and the Lincoln Financial Group. He also served as Marketing Director for a pharmaceutical services company in Yardley, Penn.

Okenquist joined Beta Theta Pi in 1991 as a founding father of the colony at Villanova. He held several roles in his colony and chapter, and he was elected as vice president of the Interfraternity Council. He served as Chief of District VI (then comprised of chapters at Lehigh, Pennsylvania, Penn State, Villanova, West Chester and Dickinson) from 1996-2004, and he was named District Chief of the Year in 1998. He served as Regional Director of Region N from 2004-2009 and was named Regional Director of the Year in 2007. Okenquist also served as Assistant District Chief, Chapter Counselor for the Zeta Sigma Chapter at West Chester University and President of the Zeta Epsilon Alumni Association.

In addition to a bachelor's degree in history, Okenquist earned an MBA from Temple University. He and his wife
