David E. Schmidt was elected the 30th General Secretary of Beta Theta Pi Fraternity at 171st General Convention in Washington, D.C., in August 2010. He previously served as a Vice President on the Board of Trustees since 2005. Schmidt leads the ten-member board, which guides the activities of more than 7,000 undergraduate members on 122 campuses in the U.S. and Canada, as well some 123,000 alumni members of the 171-year-old Fraternity.

A 1992 graduate of the University of South Florida with a degree in engineering, Schmidt went on to earn his Masters in Engineering Management in 2000.

He is a senior consultant for Success Sciences, a performance improvement and consulting firm located in Tampa, Fla. He identifies the needs, and along with his team, provides human performance improvement strategies and solutions to Fortune 500 organizations around the world.

A founding father of the Zeta Beta Chapter at the University of South Florida, Schmidt has served as district chief and regional director for Beta Theta Pi. He has been a small group facilitator at the *John and Nellie Wooden Institute for Men of Principle*, the *Miller Nichols Chapter Presidents Leadership Academy* and numerous *Keystone Regional Leadership Conferences*. Schmidt is also a member of the *Men of Principle* Implementation Team.
