Joseph M. Troncale was elected as a Vice President on the Board of Trustees of Beta Theta Pi Fraternity in August 2006, and reappointed in August 2009. He is serving a three-year term on the ten-member board, which guides the activities of more than 7,000 undergraduate members on 122 campuses in the U.S. and Canada, as well some 123,000 alumni members of the 171-year-old Fraternity.

Troncale graduated from the University of Alabama in 1963 with a Bachelor of Arts degree in history. He served as a communications officer in the United States Navy (1965-69.) After completing his military tour of duty he moved to Atlanta and joined American Hospital Supply in sales. In 1973, he joined Dillard Paper Company in sales and retired in 1998. Soon thereafter, he began a business consulting service (1999-2005). Troncale joined the Finance Division of Emory University in 2006 and serves on the Contract Administration and Compliance team.

As an undergraduate, he was a member of the charter group that was installed as the Delta Theta Chapter in 1965. From 1992 to 1998, Troncale served as an advisor for the Alabama chapter. In 2003, he was appointed chief of District XIX. In 2004, he was named Rookie District Chief of the Year and in 2005 was named District Chief of the Year. In 2006, after his appointment to the Board of Trustees, he stepped down as Chief of District XIX and became the permanent District XX Chief for the chapters at Auburn and Alabama.
