Charles O. McCormick III, M.D., was appointed to the Foundation Board of Directors of Beta Theta Pi Fraternity in 2006. McCormick was a Bachelor of Arts 1972 graduate of Indiana University, and he later received his Doctor of Medicine degree from Indiana in 1975. He is an ophthalmologist and founder and owner of the Indiana Eye Clinic in Greenwood, Indiana.

McCormick is an Indiana legacy, as his father Charles O. McCormick Jr. '36 was a member of the Pi Chapter. He served as chapter counselor since the re-colonization of Pi Chapter in 2003 and as a facilitator for the *John and Nellie Wooden Institute for Men of Principle*. He attended several conventions and credits the *Men of Principle* initiative and recolonization team with enabling the Pi Chapter's resurrection.

Dr. McCormick established the McCormick Science Grant at Indiana University in 1997 and was a major donor to Bloomington's Simon Hall for science research. Pi Chapter's third home at Indiana University, 1100 North Jordan, is a major recipient of his volunteerism and treasure.

He and his wife Janet reside in Indianapolis, Indiana, and have a daughter, Amy, attending the Indiana University School of Medicine.
