John H. Stebbins was appointed as the Treasurer of the Foundation Board of Directors of Beta Theta Pi Fraternity in 2010. Stebbins also served as the Fraternity's General Treasurer from 2000-2006 and as a Vice President on the Board of Trustees in 1999 where he provided insight to the *Men of Principle* initiative. Prior to his board positions, Stebbins was chapter counselor at Emory, vice president of the Emory House Corporation, chief of District XIX and regional director. In 1996, he was honored as Beta Theta Pi's district chief of the year.

In 1997, Stebbins served on the General Fraternity's Strategic Planning Committee, which stemmed the *Men of Principle* initiative. He then served as a member of the development team for *Men of Principle* from 1998-2001. In 2005-06, Stebbins chaired the Ritual Review Task Force, which included a comprehensive review of the Fraternity's Ritual.

In his role as managing director and chief financial officer, Stebbins has responsibility for all accounting and finance functions within the firm.
